

**NEW HORIZONS COMMUNICATIONS CORP.
REGULATIONS AND SCHEDULE OF CHARGES
APPLICABLE TO THE RESOLD AND FACILITIES-BASED PROVISION OF
COMPETITIVE LOCAL EXCHANGE CARRIER
IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA**

This tariff contains the descriptions, regulations, and schedule of rates and charges applicable to the furnishing of resold and facilities-based residential and business service for Telecommunications Services furnished by New Horizons Communications Corp. (Company). The Company will mirror the local exchange calling areas and exchange area boundaries as listed in the maps in the tariffs of Verizon Pennsylvania Inc. Telephone Pa. P.U.C. No. 180A, 182, 182A, 185B and 185C, Verizon North Inc. Telephone Pa. P.U.C. No. 1, 3, 5 and 6 and Sprint/United Telephone Company of Pennsylvania Telephone Pa. P.U.C. No. 27. Local exchange calling areas and rate classes are listed in Section 10 of this tariff.

The Company's tariff is in concurrence with all applicable State and Federal Laws (including, but not limited to, 52 Pa. Code, 66 Pa. C.S., the Telecommunications Act of 1996), and with the Commission's applicable Rules and Regulations and Orders. Any provisions contained in this Tariff that are inconsistent with the foregoing mentioned will be deemed inoperative and superseded.

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SECTION 8.0 - DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE AND DIRECTORY LISTING SERVICES

8.1 Directory Assistance Services

8.1.1 Directory Assistance

- A Directory Assistance charge applies per local directory assistance call. The Customer is allowed two (2) requests for Directory Assistance per call. Residential customers will be provided two (2) free Directory Assistance calls per month.

8.2.1 Operator Call Completion

8.2.1 Description

- A. This service provides customers who have received a requested intraLATA telephone number from directory assistance service, the option of having an intraLATA call dialed and completed to that requested telephone number, where suitable facilities exist.
- B. Operator Call Completion is available with all telephone numbers in the Telephone Company's directory assistance service data base except the following numbers: (1).InterLATA numbers; (2) 2.700, 800 and 900 numbers; (3).976 and 540 (IDS) numbers; (4).920 and 970 (Circuit 9 service) numbers and (5) 550 (GBS) numbers

8.2.2 Application of Rates and Charges

- A. The charge for Operator Call Completion is in addition to the applicable direct dialed or operator assisted directory assistance service rates, local usage charges, Message Telecommunications Service (MTS) rates, and calling card, collect and bill to third number incremental charges.
- B. The charge for Operator Call Completion applies for each call dialed and completed for the customer except when the calling party is identified as being handicapped and unable to dial the call because of the handicap.

8.3 Directory Listings

8.3.1 General

The following rules apply to standard listings in light face type in the white pages (alphabetical section) of the telephone directory and to the Directory Assistance records of the Company.

Only information necessary to identify the Customer is included in these listings. The Company uses abbreviations in listings. The Company may reject a residence listing, which is judged to be advertising. It may also reject a listing it judges to be objectionable. A name made up by adding a term such as Company, Shop, Agency, Works, etc. to the name of a commodity or service will not be accepted as a listing unless the subscriber is legally doing business under that name.

A name may be repeated in the white pages only when a different address or telephone number is used.

8.2.2 Non-Listed Numbers

At the request of the customer, the numbers of initial dial tone lines may be omitted from the directory only. These numbers are designated as "Non-Listed Telephone Numbers" and are included in the Directory Assistance Records of the Telephone Company. The Telephone Company shall not be liable to the customer for losses or damages arising from such an arrangement. The customer indemnifies and saves the Telephone Company harmless from any and all claims arising from such an arrangement.

8.2.3 Non-Published Service

Non-published service means that the Customer's telephone number is not listed in the directory, nor does it appear in the Company's Directory Assistance Records.

A. Regulations

This service is subject to the rules and regulations for E911 service, where applicable. The Company will complete calls to a non-published number only when the caller dials direct or gives the operator number. No exceptions will be made, even if the caller says it is an emergency.

When the Company agrees to keep a number unlisted, it does so without any obligation. Except for cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct, the Company is not liable for any damages that might arise from publishing a non-published number in the directory or disclosing it to some. If, in error, the telephone number is published in the directory, the Company's only obligation is to credit or refund any monthly charges the Customer paid for non-published service.

The subscriber indemnifies and save the Company harmless against any and all claims for damages caused or claimed to have been caused, directly or indirectly, by the publication of a non-published service or the disclosing of said number to any person.
